To overcome this issue we have developed a project which can access web pages through telecom SMS. This can be done by using GSM modem. This acts as an SMS server. PC connected to the internet will act as a web server and for interfacing web server and SMS server, python is used. The query will be sent in the SMS text format. Python does the function of HTML parsing .The client is the mobile handset through which queries are sent through SMS text format. Python recognizes the URL sent by the android application to the server in SMS format. Python also collects information from the web server and HTML parsing is done. Finally, the message is sent to the mobile handset. The message is received by the Android application in the handset and is converted to HTML and the webpage is opened in a web browser.




Figure 1 .Diagram of an SMS-based market information system




Fig.5.2 Python program

INTRODUCTION

A web server is a server software or hardware that processes requests via HTTP (i.e.) the Hypertext Transfer Protocol. Through HTTP the communication between the client and the server is done. The incoming networks are processed by the web server and serves contents to the World Wide Web.

A web server usually serves content using the HTTP (Hypertext Transfer Protocol). The contents are mostly HTML images and documents but any type of file can be included.

An IP address (Internet Protocol add**ress**) is nothing but an identifier which is assigned to each computer and other device connected to a TCP/IP Network that is used to locate and identify the node in communications with other nodes on the network.

Domain Name System (or Service or Server), an Internet service that translates domain names into IP addresses. Because domain names are alphabetic, they are easier to remember. The Internet however, is really based on IP addresses. Whenever a domain name is used , a DNS server will translate the domain name into its corresponding IP address. For example, the domain name www.example.com might translate to 198.105.232.4.




Fig.6.1. Working of a web server

When you enter in the address field of your browser the URL http://www.aprelium.com/doc/sample.html

First, the browser slices the URL in 3 parts:

- http://: This indicates the document to be accessed can be extracted from the web server. The standard form of communication between the browsers and the web servers is the HTTP protocol.
- www.aprelium.com: The required document can be downloaded from this host name
- /doc/sample.html: This indicates the virtual path of the document in the www.aprelium.com's web server.

The IP address of the computer will be calculated by the DNS server when the domain name www.aprelium.com is given. The ISP or the company generally runs the domain name server.

A connection channel is established by the browser with the web server on the computer in which the IP address was given by the DNS server and it requests the document on the host whose name is www.aprelium.com and which virtual path is doc/sample.html. The host name has to be specified by the browser as modern web servers has the ability to serve more than a single computer having a single IP address only. In such a case, the IP address of this computer is associated with more than one domain name.

The requests are decoded and the virtual path is mapped to a real one by the server such that it matches the existing file. The file is sent to the browser by the server with some useful information such as its last modification time and its MIME type. The browser decides how to display the receive documents using the Multipurpose Internet Mail Extension (MIME), in the considered example, it is found to be an HTML file. Thus the server sets its MIME type to text/html format and hence the browser understands that the file should be rendered in the form of text.

Sometimes a URL is entered without an explicit filename such as http://www.aprelium.com/doc. The browser sends the request to the web server as in the previous example. The server detects that the virtual path maps to a directory and not to a file. It searches then in this directory an index file. Index files are usually named index.html or index.htm. If it example index.html, it acts as if the requested URL washttp://www.aprelium.com/doc/index.html. If no index file is found, the web server generates a listing of the directory contents and sends it to the browser or reports an error.

Apache HTTP Server

This is the most popular web server. The Apache Software Foundation developed it. Apache web server is open source software. It can be installed on almost all OS including Linux, UNIX, Windows, FreeBSD, Mac OS X and more. About 60% of the web server machines run the Apache Web Server.

- Make sure that your centered text now reads "Hello world! Welcome to my app!"




Fig.7.2.2 Editing the Welcome Message in Main Activity

It helps to pull particular contents from a webpage, remove the HTML markup, and save the required information. It is a web scraping tool that helps you to clean up and parse the documents you have pulled down from the web.




Fig 8. Waiting for SMS
