

# A Proposal for Eco Tourism Planning of Don Area in Dang District of Gujarat

  - 5. Hotel for staying purpose.

# 2. STUDY AREA PROFILE

#### 2.1 Don Hill Station Profile

The present investigation is conveyed to anticipating new visitors goal of Don Hill station of Dang Region. Don hill station is situated on a higher point in the Dang forest area of Sahyadri range at an altitude of about 1000 meters, higher than the nearby Saputara. It is located 33 km from Ahwa and 55 km from Saputara. Earlier the hill station was 85 km away but the distance was shortened after the construction of a new road in 2013. Don hill station is situated on 0°42'46.1"N 73°49'5.9"E coordinates.

# 2.2 Don Hill Station Profile

Electricity is one of the chief importance necessities for the economic development of the district. The main source for power supply in the district is Gujarat Electricity Board (GEB). All the inhabited villages are electrified under Jyoti Gram project.

There is no airport in Dang district. Nearest airport from Ahwa is at Surat; which is situated at a distance of 139 km and it is well connected to Delhi, Ahmedabad and Jaipur.

The small village has a climate that is consistently pleasant, leaning towards chilly, Throughout the year. This hill station having a population around 1300 tribal, is in its biodiversity and natural relics and has a rich "Dangi" heritage. The hill is set to become the second hill station of Gujarat after Saputara.

#### • Dang Darbar- a traditional festival of Don hill station - Dang district

The most important things to let traditionalism and ritualism of the village alive is to celebrate the traditional festivals in the village every year with everyone who lived there. Thus it is very important to let alive the traditionalism of the village nowadays, because, people started to forgot the traditionalism and the importance of the festivals.

Dangs Darbar is a fair organized during the Holi festival in Dangs district of Gujarat, India. Five old Dang Darbars are given shirpav by the government in Dangs Darbar. At the Dang Darbar, traditionally held in the Dang area, tribal people performed their dances and music and it was celebrated as a festival.



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## • Trekking Activities at the hill station

Nowadays, tourism has become increasing day by day as people taking interesting in visit more and more place. There are different types of tourism like ecotourism, religious tourism, academic tourism, etc. and youngsters mostly attracted by eco- tourism, adventurous tourism, etc. thus it is very necessary to develop such natural places as a ecotourism spot and maintainit.
